Across 4 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.25(3) Requires the Center and Surrounding Premises to Be Kept Clean, Free of Debris and in Good Repair. Hygienic Measures Such As, but Not Limited To, Screened Windows and Proper Waste Disposal Procedures Shall Be Utilized to Minimize the Presence of Rodents, Flies, Roaches and Other Vermin at the Center. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Toilet in the Green Room Was Not Wor (2), 591-1-1-17(7) Requires That Children Wash Their Hands with Liquid Soap and Warm Running Water Upon Arrival for Care, When Moving From One Child Care Group to Another, Upon Re-entering the Child Care Area After Outside Play, Before and After Eating Meals and Snacks, Handling or Touching Food, Playing in Water (1), and 591-1-1-.09(1)(l)3. Requires the Center to Immediately Require a New Comprehensive Records Check Determination for a Director, Employee or Provisional Employee at Least Once Every Five Years. It Was Determined Based on Review of Records That Staff Members #9 and #15 Did Not Have Evidence of a Current Comprehensive Records Check Determination. A One Day Letter Was Left. (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.
