Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.26(4) Requires That Playgrounds Be Protected From Traffic or Other Hazards by a (4) Four Foot High Fence or Other Barrier Approved by This Department. Fencing Material Shall Not Present a Hazard to Children and Shall Be Maintained So as to Prevent Children From Leaving the Playground Area by Any Means Other Than Through an Approved Access Route. Fence Gates Shall Be Kept Closed Except Whe (2), 591-1-1-.06(4) Requires a Center First Licensed After March 1, 1991, and Centers That Remodel or Add to Existing Plumbing Facilities, to Have the Bathroom Area Fully Enclosed and Ventilated to the Outside of the Building with Either an Open Screened Window or Functioning Exhaust Fan and Duct System and Requires Centers Without Fully Enclosed Bathrooms to Ensure There Is Adequate Ventilation to Con (1), and 591-1-1-.32(7) Requires That Children Be Supervised at All Times Appropriate to the Individual Age, Needs and Capabilities of Each Child. Such Supervision Must Include, but Not Be Limited To, Indoor and Outdoor Activities, Mealtimes, Naptime, Transportation, Field Trips, and Transitions Between Activities. "Supervision" Means That the Appropriate Number of Staff Members Are Physically Present in T (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
