Across 4 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.14(1)(a) Requires All Staff Who Provide Direct Care to Children Must Obtain Certification in a Biennial Training Program in Pediatric Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and a Triennial Training Program in Pediatric First Aid Within the First 45 Days of Employment. Current and Valid Evidence of the Successful Completion of Such Training Shall Be Maintained on the Center's Premises. The Ho (1), 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Right Side of the White Sink Located in the Second Left Infant Room Had a Door That Was Unlocked with the Following Hazardous Items Accessible: 1) Sunscreen 2) Calamine Spray 3) 1st Aid Kit (1), and 591-1-1-.07(5) Requires Center Staff to Not Permit Children to Wear Around Their Necks or Attach to Their Clothing Pacifiers or Other Hazardous Items. It Was Determined Based on Observation That an Infant in the Front Left Room Had a Pink Pacifier Leash Connected to Their Shirt. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
