Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 290-2-3-.19(1)(a)3 Requires That Each Crib and Other Equipment Approved for Infant Sleep Shall Have Only an Individual, Tight-fitting Sheet Which Is Changed Daily or More Often as Needed and Prior to a Change of Occupant. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Sheet for the Crib Was Loose and Not Tight-fitting as Required. (1), 290-2-3-.08(2) Requires the Home to Maintain a File for Each Child That Includes Evidence of Age-appropriate Immunizations or a Signed Affidavit Against Such Immunizations (1), and 290-2-3-.13(2)(d) Requires That Outside Play Areas Be Protected From Traffic or Other Hazards by Fencing or Other Barriers at Least Four Feet in Height and Approved by the Department. Fencing Material Shall Not Present a Hazard to Children. A Fence Shall Be Provided Around Swimming Pools to Make Them Inaccessible When Not in Use. It Was Determined Based on Observation That There Was a Gap in the F (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
