Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 290-2-3-.13(1) Requires That the Home Be Clean and Free From Hazards. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Toilet Bowl Lid Did Not Fit Securely on the Back of the Toilet Bowl and the Base of the Toilet Had Screws Exceeding 2 Threads Posing a Potential Hazard While Accessible to Children. Additionally on the Bathroom Left Wall Pipes Were Exposed Coming From the Wall Posing a Potential Ha (3) and 290-2-3-.11(2)(c) Requires That Documentation of Drills Required by These Rules Shall Be Maintained in the Home. The Home Shall Conduct Drills for Fire, Tornado, and Other Emergency Situations. The Fire Drills Will Be Conducted Monthly and Tornado and Other Emergency Situation Drills Will Be Conducted Every Six Months.
