Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.12(4) Requires That Equipment and Furniture Is Secured if It Is of a Weight or Mass That Could Cause Injury From Tipping, Falling, or Being Pulled or Pushed Over. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Two Year Old Classroom Had a Large Black Fan That Was Located on Top of the Cubby Shelf and It Was Not Secured to Prevent a Tipping Hazard. (2), Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.29(3) Requires the Director or Designated Person-in-charge to Report or Cause to Be Reported to the Department Within Twenty-four (24) Hours or the Next Work Day: Any Death of a Child While in the Care of the Center (1), and 591-1-1-.26(8) Requires Climbing and Swinging Equipment to Have a Resilient Surface Beneath the Equipment and the Fall Zone From Such Equipment Must Be Adequately Maintained by the Center to Assure Continuing Resiliency. It Was Determined That There Were Only Two Inches of Mulch on the Toddler and Main Playground. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
