Freezer Temperature Shall Be Maintained at Zero (0) Degrees Fahrenheit or Below. It Was Determined Based on Observation That Foods Were Stored in the Refrigerator at 45 Degrees Fahrenheit on This Date. The Required Storage Temperature For (1), and 591-1-1-17(7) Requires That Children Wash Their Hands with Liquid Soap and Warm Running Water Upon Arrival for Care, When Moving From One Child Care Group to Another, Upon Re-entering the Child Care Area After Outside Play, Before and After Eating Meals and Snacks, Handling or Touching Food, Playing in Water (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.
