Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation in Room B That the Cabinet Under the Sink Was Unlocked, Allowing Children Access to White Vinegar and Other Hazards Items. Additionally, a Green Teacher's Purse Was Left on Top of the Black File Cabinet Within Reach of Chi (1), 591-1-1-.26(8) Requires Climbing and Swinging Equipment to Have a Resilient Surface Beneath the Equipment and the Fall Zone From Such Equipment Must Be Adequately Maintained by the Center to Assure Continuing Resiliency. It Was Determined Based on Observation on the Playground Along the Back Right Fence Line That There Is a Drop-off and a Hole Forming, Creating an Uneven Surface and Posing a Hazard (1), and 591-1-1-.08(1) Requires the Center Staff to Maintain a File for Each Child While Such Child Is in Care and for One Year After That Child Is No Longer Enrolled. In Order for the File to Be Complete, the File Shall Contain the Following: Child's Name, Birth Date, Sex, Address, Living Arrangement, Name of School if Applicable (1).
