Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation That There Were Disinfecting Wipes and "Lysol" Spray Stored Within Reach of Children in Classrooms Rm. B, Rm. F, and Rm. G. (1), Complete Documentation of Transportation Observed on This Date. Comment The Vehicle Had an Approved Fire Extinguisher and First Aid Kit on This Date. Finding 591-1-1-.36(4)(a) Requires an Annual Safety Check for Each Vehicle.
