Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Director Provided Two File(s) for Employees Hired Since Last Visit on January 7, 2026 (1), 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation That in the BL Classroom Small Glass Ladybugs Used for Counting Were Observed to Be Accessible to Children and a Possible Choking Hazard. It Was Also Observed That Plastic and Vinyl Gloves Were Accessible in the Back Rear (1), and 591-1-1-.26(8) Requires Climbing and Swinging Equipment to Have a Resilient Surface Beneath the Equipment and the Fall Zone From Such Equipment Must Be Adequately Maintained by the Center to Assure Continuing Resiliency. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Resilient Surface Under All Equipment on Playground A Measured to Be Less Than One Inch. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
