Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 290-2-3-.11(2)(c) Requires That Documentation of Drills Required by These Rules Shall Be Maintained in the Home. The Home Shall Conduct Drills for Fire, Tornado, and Other Emergency Situations. The Fire Drills Will Be Conducted Monthly and Tornado and Other Emergency Situation Drills Will Be Conducted Every Six Months. The Home Shall Maintain Documentation of the Dates and Times of These Drills Fo (2), 290-2-3-.08(8)(b) Requires That the Family Child Care Learning Home Have Policies and Procedures Which Shall Include Written Procedures for the Following: 1.
