Across 1 inspection since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation That a Book Bag in Room A Was Accessible to Children and Contained Sunscreen, Carmex Lip Balm, Hand Sanitizer, Aveeno Eczema Cream, Tru Kids Eczema Sunscreen, Cera Ve Healing Ointment, and a Small Bottle of Fireball Alcoho (1), 591-1-1-.36(3)(a-b) Requires Any Center That Provides Any Type of Transportation to Obtain Two (2) Hours of State- Approved or State-accepted Transportation Training, Biannually, for the Director and for Each Person Responsible for or Who Participates in the Transportation of Children. The Training Shall Include, but Is Not Limited To, a Review of the Transportation Rules, a Review of Approved Tra (1), and Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.17(2) Requires That Personnel, to the Extent Possible, Keep Children Clean, Dry and Comfortable. It Was Determined Based on Investigative Findings That on March 4, 2024 Personnel Did Not Keep a Three-year-old Child Clean, Dry, and Comfortable When the Child Was Observed Running Around Outside with No Pants or Underwear.
