Hygienic Measures Such As, but Not Limited To, Screened Windows and Proper Waste Disposal Procedures Shall Be Utilized to Minimize the Presence of Rodents, Flies, Roaches and Other Vermin at the Center. It Was Determined Based on Observation the Following Were in Need of Repair and Pose (1), 591-1-1-.32(4) Requires That Children Under Three Years Old Be Housed in Separate Physical Areas From Older Children and Cannot Be Mixed with Older Children Except at Specified Times and Circumstances. It Was Determined Based on Observation That There Were Five 2-year-old Children in B - Middle Room with Two 4-year-Old Children That Posed a Safety Hazard.
