Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.26(9) Requires the Playground to Be Kept Clean, Free From Litter and Free of Hazards, Such as but Not Limited to Rocks, Exposed Tree Roots and Exposed Sharp Edges of Concrete. It Was Determined Based on Observation That These Hazards Were Posed: --The Remainder of a Steel Pole That Was Cut Off and Had Sharp Edges Was Exposed to the Immediate Front Left of the Door at the Entrance of the P (2), 591-1-1-.25(3) Requires the Center and Surrounding Premises to Be Kept Clean, Free of Debris and in Good Repair. Hygienic Measures Such As, but Not Limited To, Screened Windows and Proper Waste Disposal Procedures Shall Be Utilized to Minimize the Presence of Rodents, Flies, Roaches and Other Vermin at the Center. It Was Determined Based on Observation That These Hazards Were Present: Room A: A Pu (2), and 591-1-1-.14(2)(b) Requires That There Must Always Be One Staff Person Present in Each Classroom Where Children Are Present That Has Current and Valid Pediatric Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and Pediatric First Aid Training.
