Across 1 inspection since 2026, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.12(2) Requires That All Equipment and Furniture Be Free From Hazardous Conditions Such As, but Not Limited To, Sharp Rough Edges or Toxic Paint (1), 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Following Potentially Hazardous Items Were Stored Accessible to Children: Room E PreK- Hand Sanitizer on a Desk, Lysol Spray in an Unlocked Cabinet Room F PreK- a Lighter in an Unlocked Drawer (1), and Discussed Maintenance of Resilient Surface. Please Fluff and Redistribute. Finding 591-1-1-.26(6) Requires That Playground Equipment Provide an Opportunity for the Children to Engage in a Variety of Experiences and Shall Be Age-appropriate. For Example, Toddlers Shall Not Be Permitted to Swing in Swings Designed for School-age Children. The Outdoor Equipment Shall Be Free of Lead-based Paint, Shar (1).
