Across 4 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.26(9) Requires the Playground to Be Kept Clean, Free From Litter and Free of Hazards, Such as but Not Limited to Rocks, Exposed Tree Roots and Exposed Sharp Edges of Concrete. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the PVC Pipe Located Around the Toddler Playground Was Disconnected in the Far Back Corner and It Presented a Tripping Hazard.
