Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.26(8) Requires Climbing and Swinging Equipment to Have a Resilient Surface Beneath the Equipment and the Fall Zone From Such Equipment Must Be Adequately Maintained by the Center to Assure Continuing Resiliency. It Was Determined, Based on Observation, the Resilient Surfacing Located in the Fall Zones of the Tall Climbing Equipment on Playground A- Preschool - Afterschool Measured Approxi (2), 591-1-1-.36(4)(b) Requires That the Interior of a Transportation Vehicle Be Clean, in Safe Repair and Free of Hazardous Items, Objects And/or Other Non-essential Items Which Could Cause Injury.
