Across 4 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 290-2-3-.13(2)(a) Requires That Outdoor Play Areas Be Kept Clean and Free of Hazards Such as Exposed Sharp Corners of Concrete or Equipment, Rust and Splinters on Equipment, Broken Glass, Open Drainage Ditches, Holes and Stagnant Water. It Was Determined Based on Observation That There Were Two Mounds of Sticks and Brush Accessible to Children on the Right Side of the Playground. (2), 290-2-3-.11(2)(f) Requires That Poisons, Medicines, Cleaning Agents and Other Hazardous Materials Be in Locked Areas or Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation That a Container of Hand Sanitizer Was Stored on a Shelf Accessible to Children in the Education Room. (2), and 290-2-3-.21(1)(a) Requires the Home to Ensure That the Provider, Every Actual and Potential Employee(including Residents Age 17 and Older) and Provisional Employee of the Family Child Care Learning Home Has Submitted Both a Records Check Application to the Department and Fingerprints to an Authorized Fingerprinting Site. It Was Determined Based on Review of Records That Staff Members #1 and #2 Did (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
