Across 4 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.36(7)(c)2. Requires That the Driver or Other Designated Person Shall Immediately Document in Writing, with a Check or Other Mark/symbol to Account for Each Child Listed on the Passenger Transportation Checklist Each Time a Child Enters and Exits the Vehicle. The Driver or Other Designated Staff Person Shall Document in Writing with a Different Mark/symbol to Account for Each Child Listed (2), 591-1-1-.33(3) Requires Each Staff Member with Direct Care Responsibilities to Complete Health and Safety Orientation Training Within the First 90 Days of Employment. The State-approved Training Hours Obtained Will Count Toward Required First Year Training Hours. The Training Must Address the Following Health and Safety Topics: Prevention and Control of Infectious Diseases (Including Immunizations (1), and 591-1-1-.25(13) - Please Ensure That Closets Are in Good Repair Where Hazards Are Stored.
