The Comprehensive Records Check Determination Must Have a Records Check Clearance Date That Is No Older Than the Preceding 12 Months of the Hire (1), The Provider Will Ensure That Outdoor Play Areas Be Kept Clean and Free of Hazards Such as Exposed Sharp Corners of Concrete or Equipment, Rust and Splinters on Equipment, Broken Glass, Open Drainage Ditches, Holes and Stagnant Water. There Were Weeds Growing From Outside of the Fence Into the Inside of the Child Play Area.
