Across 1 inspection since 2025, the issues cited most often were 290-2-3-.19(1)(C) - Please Ensure That Pillows Are Used Only by Children Two (2) Years of Age or Older. When Used, Pillows Shall Be Assigned for Individual Use and Covered with Pillow Cases That Are Marked for Individual Use or Covered with Cases That Are Laundered Daily. Individually Marked Pillow Cases Shall Be Laundered Weekly or More Frequently as Needed. (1), 290-2-3-.11(2)(c) Requires That Documentation of Drills Required by These Rules Shall Be Maintained in the Home. The Home Shall Conduct Drills for Fire, Tornado, and Other Emergency Situations. The Fire Drills Will Be Conducted Monthly and Tornado and Other Emergency Situation Drills Will Be Conducted Every Six Months. The Home Shall Maintain Documentation of the Dates and Times of These Drills Fo (1), and 290-2-3-.13(2)(c) Requires That Climbing and Swinging Equipment That Are Not Portable Have a Resilient Surface Beneath the Equipment and the Fall Zone From Such Equipment, Which Is Adequately Maintained by the Home to Assure Continuing Resiliency. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Resilient Surface Beneath the Swings and Equipment Measured Less Than 6 Inches. Georgia Department of Ea (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
