It Was Determined Based on an Investigation That on April 20, (1), 591-1-1-.26(4) Requires That Playgrounds Be Protected From Traffic or Other Hazards by a (4) Four Foot High Fence or Other Barrier Approved by This Department. Fencing Material Shall Not Present a Hazard to Children and Shall Be Maintained So as to Prevent Children From Leaving the Playground Area by Any Means Other Than Through an Approved Access Route. Fence Gates Shall Be Kept Closed Except Whe (1), and 591-1-1-.20(3) Requires the Center to Maintain a Record of Medication Dispensed That Includes the Date, Time and Amount of Medication, Any Noticeable Adverse Reaction, and the Signature or Initials of the Person Administering the Medication.
