Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.09(1)(j) Requires That for Portability for Directors, Employees and Provisional Employees, Excluding Students-in-Training, Only the Most Recently Issued Determination Letter Is Eligible for Portability and Must Be Ported Electronically. A Center May Accept a Satisfactory Fingerprint Records Check Determination Letter or a Satisfactory Comprehensive Records Check Determination Letter Issue (1), 591-1-1-.32(1) Requires the Center to Maintain the Required Staff:child Ratios as Follows: Under 1 Year or Under 18 Months if Not Walking = 1:6 (1), and 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Following Hazards Were Observed: Classroom D-L -A Broom, Dust Pan, and Clothes Hamper Were Located in the Bathroom Was Accessible to Children. Classroom F-L -A Broom, Dust Pan, and Trash Can Were Located in the Ba (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
