● 4 Important

Across 4 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation That in Main A - 3's and 4's, Several Brooms Were Located in the Corner Next to the Child's Hand Washing Sink and Were in Reach of the Children in Care. (2), Staff Stated Proper Knowledge of Diapering Procedures. Finding 591-1-1-.10(6) Requires Center Staff to Keep Any Items Which Might Harm a Child Out of a Child's Reach. It Was Determined Based on Observation That in EHS Room Main C-Infant/Toddler, a Pack of Wipes and a Box of Latex Gloves Were Located on Top of the Changing Table and Within the Reach of Children. (1), and 591-1-1-.26(9) Requires the Playground to Be Kept Clean, Free From Litter and Free of Hazards, Such as but Not Limited to Rocks, Exposed Tree Roots and Exposed Sharp Edges of Concrete. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Head Start Playground on the Left Side of the Center Contained Four Live Ant Beds That Had Not Been Treated. (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.
