Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 290-2-3-.09(5) Requires That Children Less Than Three (3) Years of Age Shall Not Spend More Than One-half (1/2) Hour of Time Consecutively in Confining Equipment, Such as Swings, Highchairs, Jumpseats, Carriers or Walkers. Children Shall Use Such Equipment Only When They Are Awake. Such Children Shall Be Allowed Time to Play on the Floor Daily. It Was Determined Based on Observation That Three Out (2), 290-2-3-.08(2) Requires the Home to Maintain a File for Each Child That Includes Evidence of Age-appropriate Immunizations or a Signed Affidavit Against Such Immunizations (1), and 290-2-3-.11(1)(i) Requires That Personnel Shall Wash Their Hands with Liquid Soap and Warm Running Water: Immediately Before and After Each Diaper Change (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.
