Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Following Hazards Were Accessible to Children: 3L: - There Were Plastic Storage Bags in the Children's Cubby. 3R (Rear): - There Was a Toilet Brush in the Children's Bathroom. - There Was One Pack of Pull Ups And (2), Bathrooms Observed to Be Clean and Well Maintained.
