Across 2 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.09(1)(a) Requires That a Center Ensure That Every Actual and Potential Director, Employee and Provisional Employee of a Child Care Learning Center Submit Both a Records Check Application to the Department and Fingerprints to an Authorized Fingerprinting Site. It Was Determined Based on a Review of Records That Staff Member #18 Was Observed to Be on Site, and Supervised by Three Staff Memb (1), 591-1-1-.12(6) Requires That a Variety of Age-appropriate Toys and Play Materials Be Available, Stored on Low, Open Shelves Accessible to Children in Each Room or Assigned Area. It Was Determined Based on Consultant's Observation the Program Lacked a Variety of Play Material in the Area of Dramatic Play, Books, Puzzles and Musical Instruments. (1), and Playground Black Top and Grassy Area Was Observed to Be Clean and in Good Repair. Finding 591-1-1-.26(6) Requires That Playground Equipment Provide an Opportunity for the Children to Engage in a Variety of Experiences and Shall Be Age-appropriate. For Example, Toddlers Shall Not Be Permitted to Swing in Swings Designed for School-age Children. The Outdoor Equipment Shall Be Free of Lead-based Pain (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.
