Across 1 inspection since 2025, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.32(2) Requires the Center Maintain Staff:child Ratios in Mixed-age Groups Based on the Age of the Youngest Group of Children That Includes More Than Twenty Percent of the Total Number of Children in the Mixed-age Group. It Was Determined Based on Observation That a Ratio of 1:9 Was Present in Classroom B-1L, Consisting of Two Infants and Seven Two-year-olds. A Second Staff Person Was Need (2), 591-1-1-.03(6) Requires Center Staff to Ensure Children Less Than Three Years of Age Do Not Spend More Than One- Half Hour of Time Consecutively in Confining Equipment, Such as Swings, Highchairs, Jump Seats, Carriers or Walkers. Children Shall Use Such Equipment Only When They Are Awake. Such Children Shall Be Allowed Time to Play on the Floor Daily.
