Across 3 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were 290-2-3-.13(2)(a) Requires That Outdoor Play Areas Be Kept Clean and Free of Hazards Such as Exposed Sharp Corners of Concrete or Equipment, Rust and Splinters on Equipment, Broken Glass, Open Drainage Ditches, Holes and Stagnant Water. It Was Determined Based on Observation That There Was One Piece of White Plastic Kitchen Set That Was Missing the Handles and Exposed Sharp Edges of Plastic That W (1), 290-2-3-.10(1) Requires That Meals and Snacks Are Served, with Serving Sizes Dependent Upon the Age of the Child That Meet Nutritional Guidelines as Established by the United States Department of Agriculture Child and Adult Care Food Program.
