● 5 Important

Across 4 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.26(9) Requires the Playground to Be Kept Clean, Free From Litter and Free of Hazards, Such as but Not Limited to Rocks, Exposed Tree Roots and Exposed Sharp Edges of Concrete. It Was Determined Based on Observation That There Was Exposed Concrete with Rough Edges at Classroom Doors as You Entered the Playground Used for Early Headstart. Further, There Were Exposed Bolts on the Fence Gate (2), 591-1-1-.06(6) Requires Center Staff to Equip Bathrooms with Soap, Toilet Tissue and Single-use Towels or Cloth Towels Used Only Once Between Launderings. It Was Determined Based on Observation and Staff Statements That Not All Classrooms Had Paper Towels for Handwashing, and Staff Stated the Center Was Out of Paper Towels. (1), and 591-1-1-.15(4) Requires That a Feeding Chair or Similar Equipment Designed for Feeding Children Shall Be Provided for the Use of Each Child Being Fed Who Is Capable of Sitting Up but Who Is Unable to Sit Unassisted at a Table and Must Be Cleaned with a Disinfectant After Each Use. Such Chair or Similar Equipment Shall Have a Broad Base to Prevent Tipping, a Surface That the Child Cannot Raise, a S (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
