Across 4 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.08(1) Requires the Center Staff to Maintain a File for Each Child While Such Child Is in Care and for One Year After That Child Is No Longer Enrolled. In Order for the File to Be Complete, the File Shall Contain the Following: Child's Name, Birth Date, Sex, Address, Living Arrangement, Name of School if Applicable (1), 591-1-1-.09(1)(a) Requires That a Center Ensure That Every Actual and Potential Director, Employee and Provisional Employee of a Child Care Learning Center Submit Both a Records Check Application to the Department and Fingerprints to an Authorized Fingerprinting Site.
