Across 1 inspection since 2026, the issues cited most often were 290-2-3-.11(2)(c) Requires That Documentation of Drills Required by These Rules Shall Be Maintained in the Home. The Home Shall Conduct Drills for Fire, Tornado, and Other Emergency Situations. The Fire Drills Will Be Conducted Monthly and Tornado and Other Emergency Situation Drills Will Be Conducted Every Six Months. The Home Shall Maintain Documentation of the Dates and Times of These Drills Fo (2) and Provider Stated Knowledge of Infant Safe Sleep Requirements. Finding 290-2-3-.19(1)(a)3 Requires That Each Crib and Other Equipment Approved for Infant Sleep Shall Have Only an Individual, Tight-fitting Sheet Which Is Changed Daily or More Often as Needed and Prior to a Change of Occupant. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Crib Sheet Was Not Washed Daily. (1). None of the 3 findings were critical.
