Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Discussed SIDS and Infant Sleeping Position. Finding 591-1-1-.30(1)(a)3 Requires That Each Crib Shall Have Only an Individual, Tight-fitting Sheet Which Is Changed Daily or More Often as Needed and Prior to a Change of Occupant. It Was Determined Based on Staff Discussion That the Infant Crib Sheets Are Washed Weekly Rather Than Daily as Required. (1), Please Be Mindful to Keep Items That Pose a Hazard Inaccessible to Children. Technical Assistance Please Ensure Flooring Is Kept Clean and Free of Stains. (1), and Please Ensure to Check the Fencing for Gaps Along the Perimeter. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
