Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.32(5) Requires That During Day-time Rest or Sleeping Periods, at Least One Staff Person Is in Each Room Providing Direct Supervision of the Children and All Staff Required by These Rules Relating to Staff: Child Ratios Are in the Center and Available to Assure Safe Evacuation in an Emergency. Staff: Child Ratios May Be Doubled for Children Three (3) Years and Old (2), 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Following Hazards Were Present: - in Main Rm E - a Pack of Wipes Within Reach of Children in the Bathroom - in Main Rm F - a Pack of Wipes on the Bathroom Floor (1), and 591-1-1-.10(6) Requires Center Staff to Keep Any Items Which Might Harm a Child Out of a Child's Reach. It Was Determined Based on Observation That in Main Rm E, a Pack of Wipes and a Bottle of Equate Baby Powder Labeled "Keep Out of Reach of Children" Were Located on Top of the Changing Table and Within the Reach of Children. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

- **591-1-1-.10(6) Requires Center Staff to Keep Any Items Which Might Harm a Child Out of a Child's Reach. It Was Determined Based on Observation That in Main Rm E, a Pack of Wipes and a Bottle of Equate Baby Powder Labeled "Keep Out of Reach of Children" Were Located on Top of the Changing Table and Within the Reach of Children.**
