Across 3 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.26(6) Requires That Playground Equipment Provide an Opportunity for the Children to Engage in a Variety of Experiences and Shall Be Age-appropriate. For Example, Toddlers Shall Not Be Permitted to Swing in Swings Designed for School-age Children. The Outdoor Equipment Shall Be Free of Lead-based Paint, Sharp Corners and Shall Be Regularly Maintained in Such a Way (1), 591-1-1-.13(6) Requires Center Staff to Have Emergency Medical Information on Each Child Who Goes on a Field Trip That Includes Allergies, Special Medical Needs and Conditions, Current Prescribed Medications Required to Be Taken on a Daily Basis for a Chronic Condition, the Name and Phone Number of the Child's Doctor, the Local Medical Facility the Center Uses in the Area Where the Center Is Locat (1), and 591-1-1-.36(7)(c)2. Requires That the Driver or Other Designated Person Shall Immediately Document in Writing, with a Check or Other Mark/symbol to Account for Each Child Listed on the Passenger Transportation Checklist Each Time a Child Enters and Exits the Vehicle. The Driver or Other Designated Staff Person Shall Document in Writing with a Different Mark/symbol to Account for Each Child Listed (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

In Addition, Staff Who Provide Direct Care to Children Must Satisfactorily Obtain Certification in First Aid and CPR by December 29, 2016 if Employed Prior to September 30, 2016 and Within 90 Days of Their Hire Date if Employed After September 30, 20**
