Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.11(2) Requires That Personnel Not: Physically or Sexually Abuse a Child or Engage or Permit Others to Engage in Sexually Overt Conduct in the Presence of Any Child Enrolled in the Center (1), 591-1-1-.30(4). Requires That if Cots and Mats Are Stored in the Children's Activity Room or Area, They Shall Be Stored to Prevent Children's Access to Them and to Allow Maximum Use of Play Space. When Storage Is Available and Used for the Storage of Cots and Mats That Allows the Cots, Mats and Any Bedding to Be Stored Without Touching Any Other Cots, Mats or Bedding, the Bedding May Be Left on Th (1), and 91-1-1-.33(5) Requires That Every Calendar Year After the First Year of Employment, All Supervisory and Caregiver Personnel, Except Independent Contractors, Students-in-Training and Volunteers Shall Attend Ten (10) Clock Hours of Diverse Training Which Is Task-focused in On-going Health, Safety and Early Childhood or Child Development Related Topics and Which Is Offered by an Accredited College, U (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

Professional Medical Care Was Obtained as a Precaution.**
