Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Following Hazards Were Observed to Be Accessible to Children on This Date: - Room 1R-Two's- the Door to the Laundry Room Was Unlocked Leaving Brooms, Mops and Mop Buckets Accessible to Children. Further, the Cabin (2), 591-1-1-.33(2)(a)-(n) Requires the Initial Center Orientation to Include the Following Subjects: A) the Center's Policies and Procedures (1), and 591-1-1-.12(6) Requires That a Variety of Age-appropriate Toys and Play Materials Be Available, Stored on Low, Open Shelves Accessible to Children in Each Room or Assigned Area.
