Across 1 inspection since 2026, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.03(2) Requires the Center to Keep Current Lesson Plans on Site That Reflect Appropriate Instruction Practices and Activities to Support Children's Development The Center Shall Have Sufficient and Varied Play and Learning Equipment and Materials to Support the Above Program of Activities in All Developmental Areas. It Was Determined Based on Observation That Classrooms Main D, Main E, Main (1), 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Following Classrooms Had Hazards Accessible to Children: -Main B: A Toilet Scrub Brush, Toilet Bowl Cleaner, and Bathroom Cleaning Spray Were Stored in the Classroom Bathroom by the Toilet -Main C: A Plunger and S (1), and 591-1-1-.26(4) Requires That Playgrounds Be Protected From Traffic or Other Hazards by a (4) Four Foot High Fence or Other Barrier Approved by This Department. Fencing Material Shall Not Present a Hazard to Children and Shall Be Maintained So as to Prevent Children From Leaving the Playground Area by Any Means Other Than Through an Approved Access Route. Fence Gates Shall Be Kept Closed Except Whe (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
