Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.09(1)(j) Requires That for Portability for Directors, Employees and Provisional Employees, Excluding Students-in-Training, Only the Most Recently Issued Determination Letter Is Eligible for Portability and Must Be Ported Electronically. A Center May Accept a Satisfactory Fingerprint Records Check Determination Letter or a Satisfactory Comprehensive Records Check Determination Letter Issue (1), Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.17(2) Requires That Personnel, to the Extent Possible, Keep Children Clean, Dry and Comfortable. It Was Determined Based on an Investigation That on October 2, 2025, Personnel Failed to Keep a 2-year-old Child Clean, Dry, and Comfortable When the Child Was Not Wiped Clean During a Diaper Change, Resulting in a Red Rash.
