Across 1 inspection since 2025, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.12(2) - Please Ensure All Vinyl Equipment Is Free of Wear and Tear in Order to Keep It Properly Cleaned and Sanitized. In Classroom A-1st RT There Was a Red, Pink, and Yellow Chair That Had Cracked Vinyl, in Classroom E-Lft Wing 2nd Left, the Blue Couch Had Cracked Vinyl. (1), 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Following Hazards Were Present in the Classrooms and Were Accessible to Children: A-1st RT: Diaper Rash Cream in the Cubbies to the Left of the Entrance. B- 2nd RT- Diaper Rash Cream Under an Unlocked Changing Tab (1), and 591-1-1-.26(6) Requires That Playground Equipment Provide an Opportunity for the Children to Engage in a Variety of Experiences and Shall Be Age-appropriate. For Example, Toddlers Shall Not Be Permitted to Swing in Swings Designed for School-age Children. The Outdoor Equipment Shall Be Free of Lead-based Paint, Sharp Corners and Shall Be Regularly Maintained in Such a Way as to Be Free of Rust And (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
