Across 4 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.29(3) Requires the Director or Designated Person-in-charge to Report or Cause to Be Reported to the Department Within Twenty-four (24) Hours or the Next Work Day: Any Death of a Child While in the Care of the Center (2), 591-1-1-.26(4) Requires That Playgrounds Be Protected From Traffic or Other Hazards by a (4) Four Foot High Fence or Other Barrier Approved by This Department. Fencing Material Shall Not Present a Hazard to Children and Shall Be Maintained So as to Prevent Children From Leaving the Playground Area by Any Means Other Than Through an Approved Access Route. Fence Gates Shall Be Kept Closed Except Whe (1), and Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.30(1)(b)4 Requires That a Light Cover Be Available for Each Child's Use on a Cot or Mat and Shall Be Marked for Individual Use or Laundered Daily. If Marked for Individual Use, They Must Be Laundered Weekly or More Frequently if Needed. It Was Determined Based on an Investigation That on June 17, 2024, Center Staff Failed to Ensure That a Light Cover Was Availabl (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
