Across 4 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.36(7)(d)1. Requires That the First Check Be Conducted Immediately Upon Unloading the Last Child at Any Location Including, but Not Limited To, a Field Trip Destination, Arrival at the Center, and the Last Stop During Transportation to Home or School. The Responsible Person on the Vehicle Shall Physically Walk Through the Entire Vehicle (1), Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.32(7) Requires That Children Be Supervised at All Times Appropriate to the Individual Age, Needs and Capabilities of Each Child. Such Supervision Must Include, but Not Be Limited To, Indoor and Outdoor Activities, Mealtimes, Naptime, Transportation, Field Trips, and Transitions Between Activities. "Supervision" Means That the Appropriate Number of Staff Members A (1), and Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.12(4) Requires That Equipment and Furniture Is Secured if It Is of a Weight or Mass That Could Cause Injury From Tipping, Falling, or Being Pulled or Pushed Over. It Was Determined Based on a Investigation That on October 3, 2024, a Six-year-old Child Sustained a Cut on Their Knee When a Locker Fell Over and Landed on Top of the Child.
