Across 4 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Discussed Maintenance of Resilient Surface. Please Fluff and Redistribute. Finding 591-1-1-.26(9) Requires the Playground to Be Kept Clean, Free From Litter and Free of Hazards, Such as but Not Limited to Rocks, Exposed Tree Roots and Exposed Sharp Edges of Concrete. It Was Determined Based on Observation on Playground A-Left Preschool in the Back There Were Exposed Tree Roots Posing a Tripping Ha (3), Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.32(7) Requires That Children Be Supervised at All Times Appropriate to the Individual Age, Needs and Capabilities of Each Child. Such Supervision Must Include, but Not Be Limited To, Indoor and Outdoor Activities, Mealtimes, Naptime, Transportation, Field Trips, and Transitions Between Activities. "Supervision" Means That the Appropriate Number of Staff Members A (1), and 591-1-1-.33(4) Requires Within the First Year of Employment, the Director and Person with Primary Responsibility for Food Preparation Shall Have Four Clock Hours of Training in Food Nutrition Planning, Preparation, Serving, Proper Dish Washing and Food Storage.
