Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.30(1)(b)3 Requires That Sheets or Similar Coverings for Cots or Mats Shall Either Be Marked for Individual Use or Laundered Daily. If Marked for Individual Use, They Must Be Laundered Weekly or More Frequently if Needed. It Was Determined Based on Observations in the Main Building in Rooms B, D, and E That There Was No Sheets Covering the Cots as Required. (2), A Variety of Equipment and Toys Were Observed Throughout the Center on This Date. Finding 591-1-1-.12(4) Requires That Equipment and Furniture Is Secured if It Is of a Weight or Mass That Could Cause Injury From Tipping, Falling, or Being Pulled or Pushed Over. It Was Determined Based on Observations That the Computer in Main Bldg Room D and Bldg 3 Room A and Room E Had Computers on the Desk That (1), and 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Following Hazards Were Not Inaccessible to Children as Required: Main Building -Room B -Baby Wipes -First Aid Bag -Hand Sanitizer Room C -Empty Ziploc Bags -Nitrile Gloves -Baby Wipes Room E -Black and Orange Shar (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
