Across 3 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were Complete First Aid Kits Observed in Center and on Vehicles on This Date. Comment Evidence Observed of 100% of Center Staff Certified in First Aid and CPR Containing Emergency Care for Infants and Children on This Date. Except for Staff That Are Still Within Their 45 Days of Hire. Finding 591-1-1-.14(1)(a) Requires All Staff Who Provide Direct Care to Children Must Obtain Certification in a Biennia (1), 591-1-1-.36(4)(b) Requires That the Interior of a Transportation Vehicle Be Clean, in Safe Repair and Free of Hazardous Items, Objects And/or Other Non-essential Items Which Could Cause Injury. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Area Around the Buckles on All Seats Was Frayed and Torn Exposing the Foam. In Addition, the Corner of the First Seat on the Passenger Sides Was Frayed and Ha (1), and 591-1-1-.26(4) Requires That Playgrounds Be Protected From Traffic or Other Hazards by a (4) Four Foot High Fence or Other Barrier Approved by This Department. Fencing Material Shall Not Present a Hazard to Children and Shall Be Maintained So as to Prevent Children From Leaving the Playground Area by Any Means Other Than Through an Approved Access Route. Fence Gates Shall Be Kept Closed Except Whe (1). None of the 3 findings were critical.
