It Was Determined Based on Review of the Records That Staff # 13, Hired on April 20, 2026 Was Present at the Center in Room J-Infan (1), Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.30(4). Requires That if Cots and Mats Are Stored in the Children's Activity Room or Area, They Shall Be Stored to Prevent Children's Access to Them and to Allow Maximum Use of Play Space. When Storage Is Available and Used for the Storage of Cots and Mats That Allows the Cots, Mats and Any Bedding to Be Stored Without Touching Any Other Cots, Mats or Bedding, The (1), and Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.32(7) Requires That Children Be Supervised at All Times Appropriate to the Individual Age, Needs and Capabilities of Each Child.
