Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 290-2-3-.12(5) Requires All Indoor and Outdoor Furniture, Activity Materials, and Equipment Shall Be Free From Hazardous Conditions Such As, but Not Limited To, Sharp Rough Edges or Toxic Paint and Kept Clean. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Blue and Red Metal Airplane Rocker on the Outdoor Playground Had an Exposed Screw on the Front Control Panel That Posed a Potential Puncture H (1) and 290-2-3-.11(1)(i) Requires That Personnel Shall Wash Their Hands with Liquid Soap and Warm Running Water: Immediately Before and After Each Diaper Change (1). None of the 2 findings were critical.
