Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.14(1)(b) Requires the Training Must Be Done by Certified or Licensed Health Care Professionals or Trainers and Must Deal with the Provision of Emergency Care to Infants and Children. It Was Determined Based on Review of Staff Records That All Staff Renewed Their CPR/First Aid Certification Online. (1), 591-1-1-.33(5)(a) Requires That Every Calendar Year After the First Year of Employment, All Supervisory and Caregiver Personnel, Except Independent Contractors, Students-in-Training and Volunteers, Shall Attend Ten (10) Clock Hours of Diverse Training Which Is Offered by an Accredited College, University or Vocational Program or Other Department-approved Source. It Was Determined Based on Review O (1), and 591-1-1-.19(1) Requires a Center to Provide 35 Square Feet of Usable Space per Child, Which Will Determine the Center's License Capacity. It Was Determined Based on Observation That Room A in Building I Had 1 Staff Member and 19 Children. The Room Has a Capacity of 17 Children, Causing This Room to Be Over the 35 Square Foot Licensed Capacity.] (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.
