Across 3 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.14(1)(a) Requires All Staff Who Provide Direct Care to Children Must Obtain Certification in a Biennial Training Program in Pediatric Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and a Triennial Training Program in Pediatric First Aid Within the First 45 Days of Employment. Current and Valid Evidence of the Successful Completion of Such Training Shall Be Maintained on the Center's Premises. The Ho (1), 591-1-1-.33(3)(a)-(k) Requires Each Staff Member with Direct Care Responsibilities to Complete Health and Safety Orientation Training Within the First 90 Days of Employment. The State-approved Training Hours Obtained Will Count Toward Required First Year Training Hours.
