Across 4 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Following Hazards Were Observed: Main 1L: (2 Years) -There Was a Wet Mop in the Boys Restroom. Main 1R (5-12 Years) -There Was a Toilet Brush Next to the Toilet in the Boys Restroom. (2), 591-1-1-.12(4) Requires That Equipment and Furniture Is Secured if It Is of a Weight or Mass That Could Cause Injury From Tipping, Falling, or Being Pulled or Pushed Over.
